**The following are the selection criteria for the students:**

TSB major from the traditional (CIS, ACC, HR, BUS), SJAFB (CIS, ACC, HR, BUS), or non-traditional (MOD, MIS, HCM) programs

1. Valid US passport or foreign passport with a multiple re-entry visa or its equivalent for the USA
2. GPA of 2.5
3. Junior/Senior status
4. Student presentation
