1. Be sure the course you are signing up for is required for your program, and meets GER or Elective requirements. If you are not certain, consult your Assessment Counselor.

#### **GER AND ELECTIVE SIGN UP PROCEDURE**

2. Complete a GER/ELECTIVE enrollment form available at New Bern.
3. The completed enrollment form **MUST** be accompanied by a \$50 per class non-refundable deposit in order to secure your enrollment. This deposit is required of all students, including those receiving financial aid. For students covered with some form of financial aid, this deposit will be credited to their account if they attend the class. If no financial aid is available to cover tuition, payment in full is required at time of registration.
4. If the class fills and has a waiting list, those students who signed up earliest will be admitted. Students on the waiting list will be added to the class beginning 15 minutes after the class scheduled first session start time. Students arriving late may lose their seat in the class.
5. For those not covered in full with some form of financial aid, veteran's benefits or employer subsidy, all fees and cost for books and materials must be paid at the time of registration.
6. Saturday and Day Classes will meet from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.  
Courses held Monday through Thursday will meet from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.
