

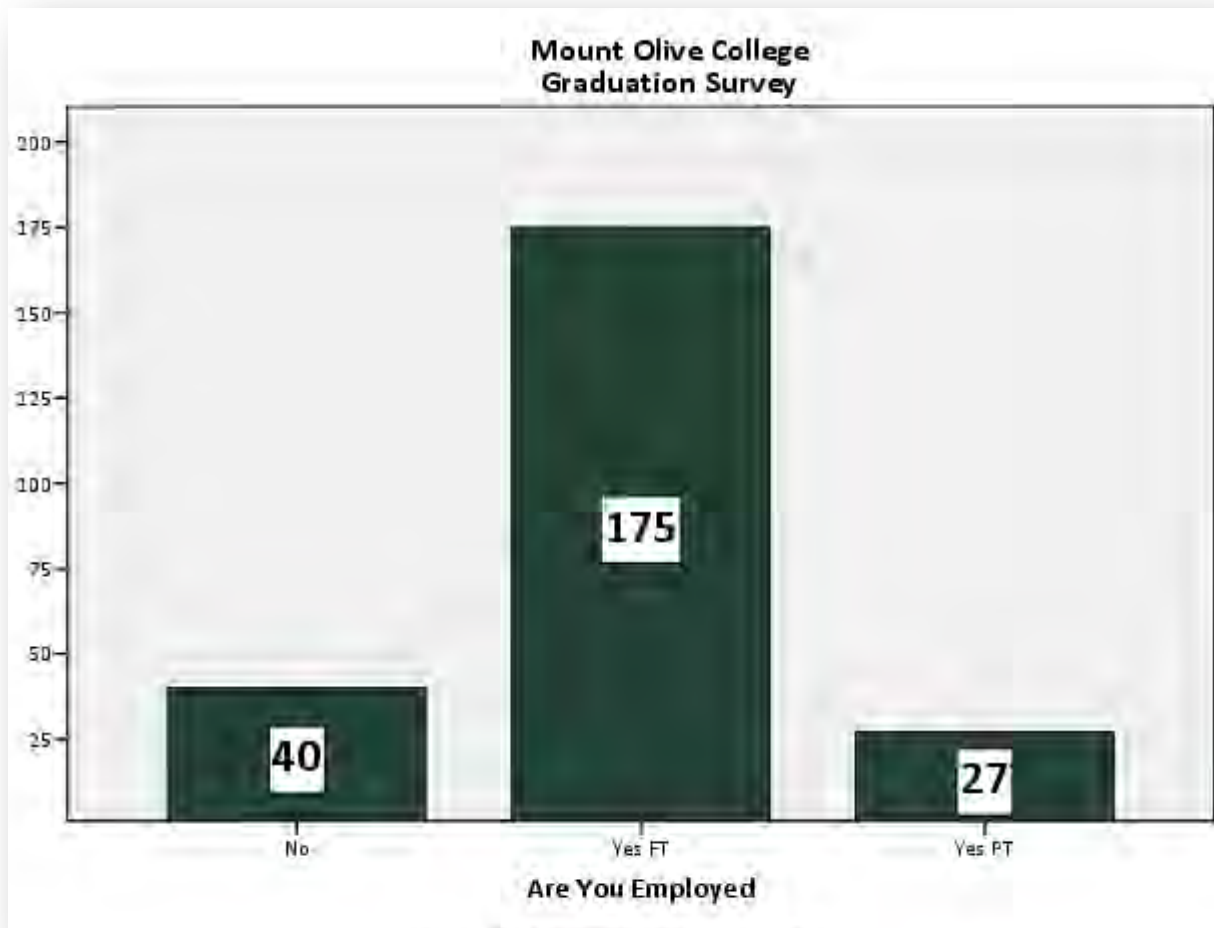
# MOUNT OLIVE COLLEGE

## Mount Olive College Graduation Survey

Mount Olive College conducts three graduations per year: **May, August, and December**. The following information is the results of the May 2009 Graduation Survey. The survey requests information such as future academic plans (graduate/professional school admissions) and employment plans.



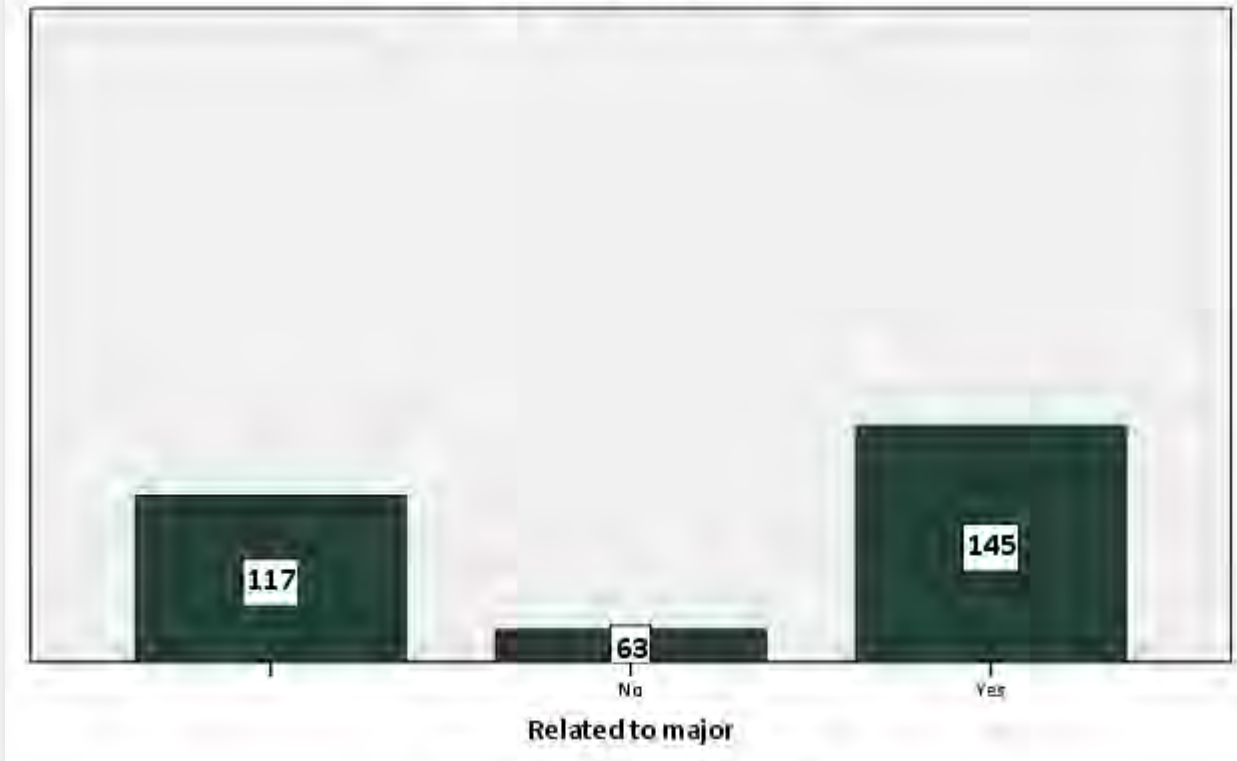
• **Figure 1: Are you employed? (May 2009 Graduates)**

## Mount Olive College Graduation Survey: May 2009

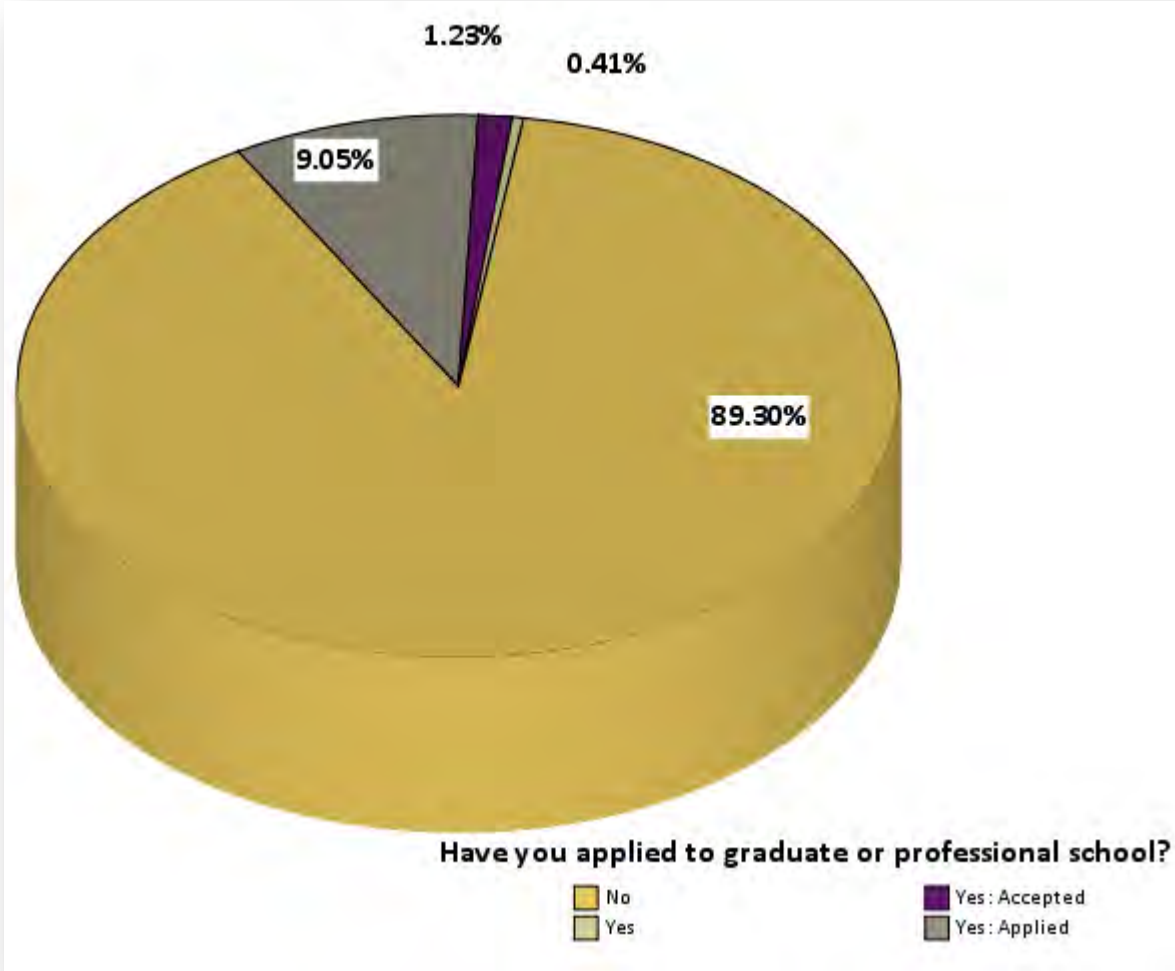
"Is your job related to your major?"

Mount Olive College requested students to report if their current job was related to the degree they just earned. 208 students responded to this question, while 117 declined to answer.

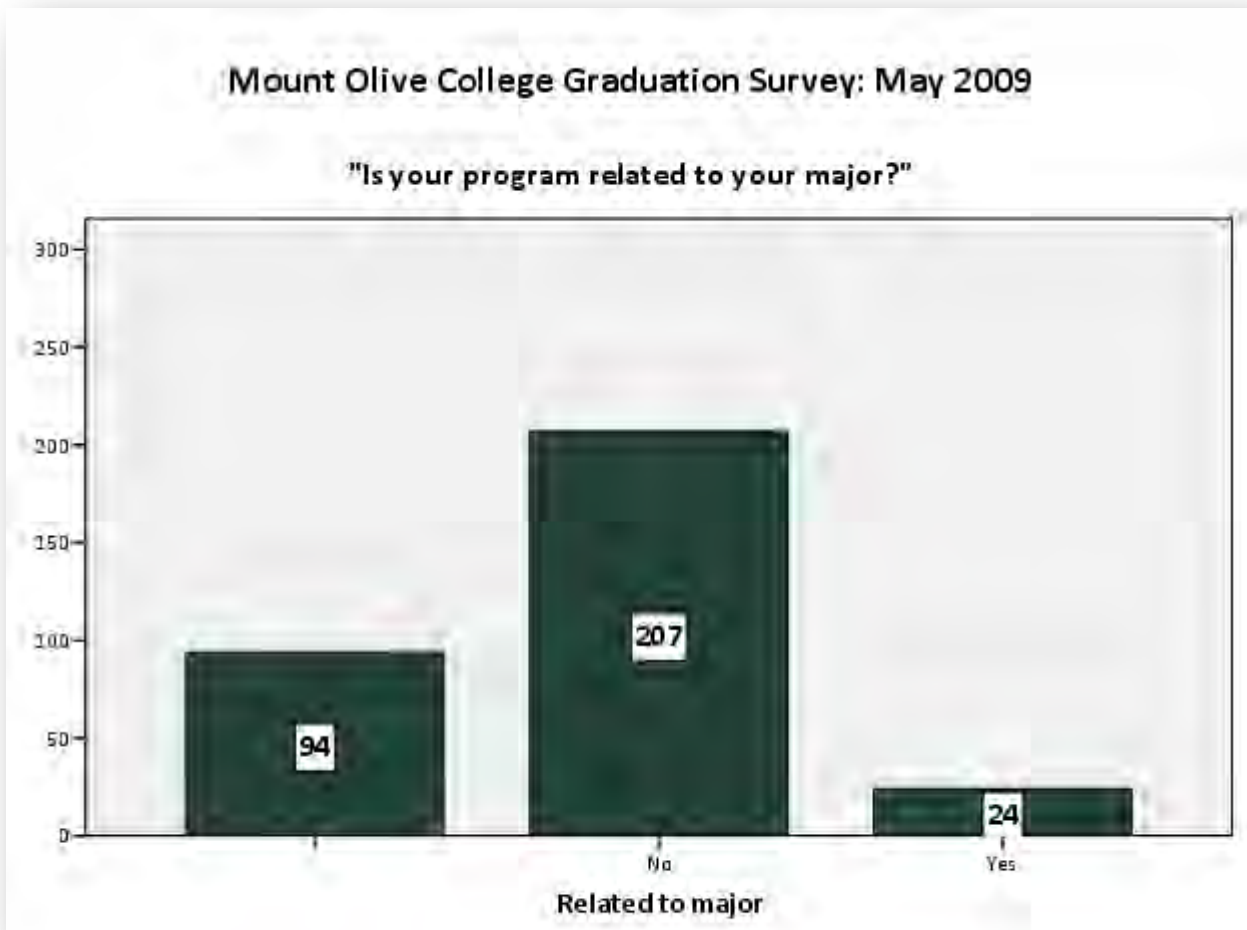

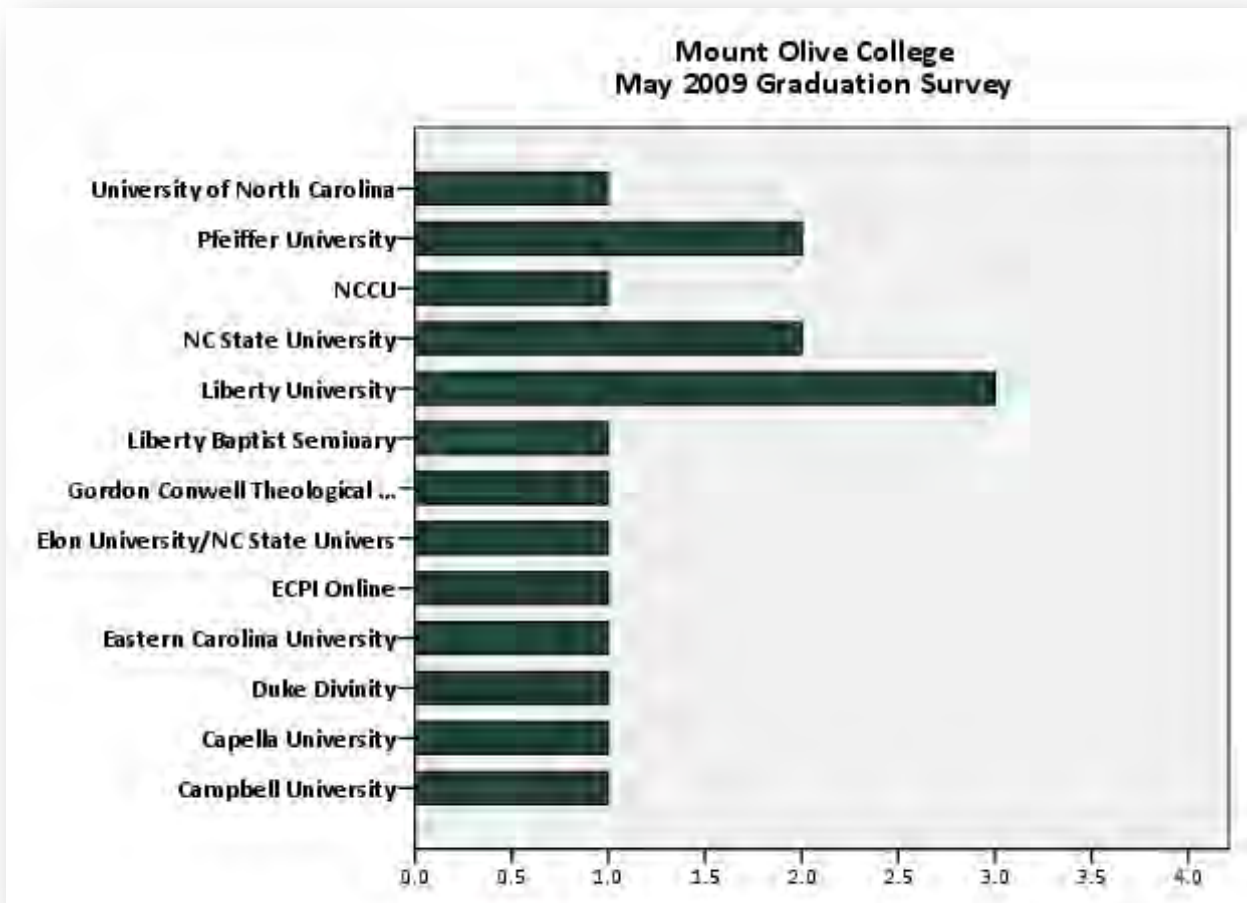

Mount Olive College requested students to report if their planned graduate or professional school program was related to their Mount Olive College degree major. 231 students responded to this question, while 94 students declined to answer.

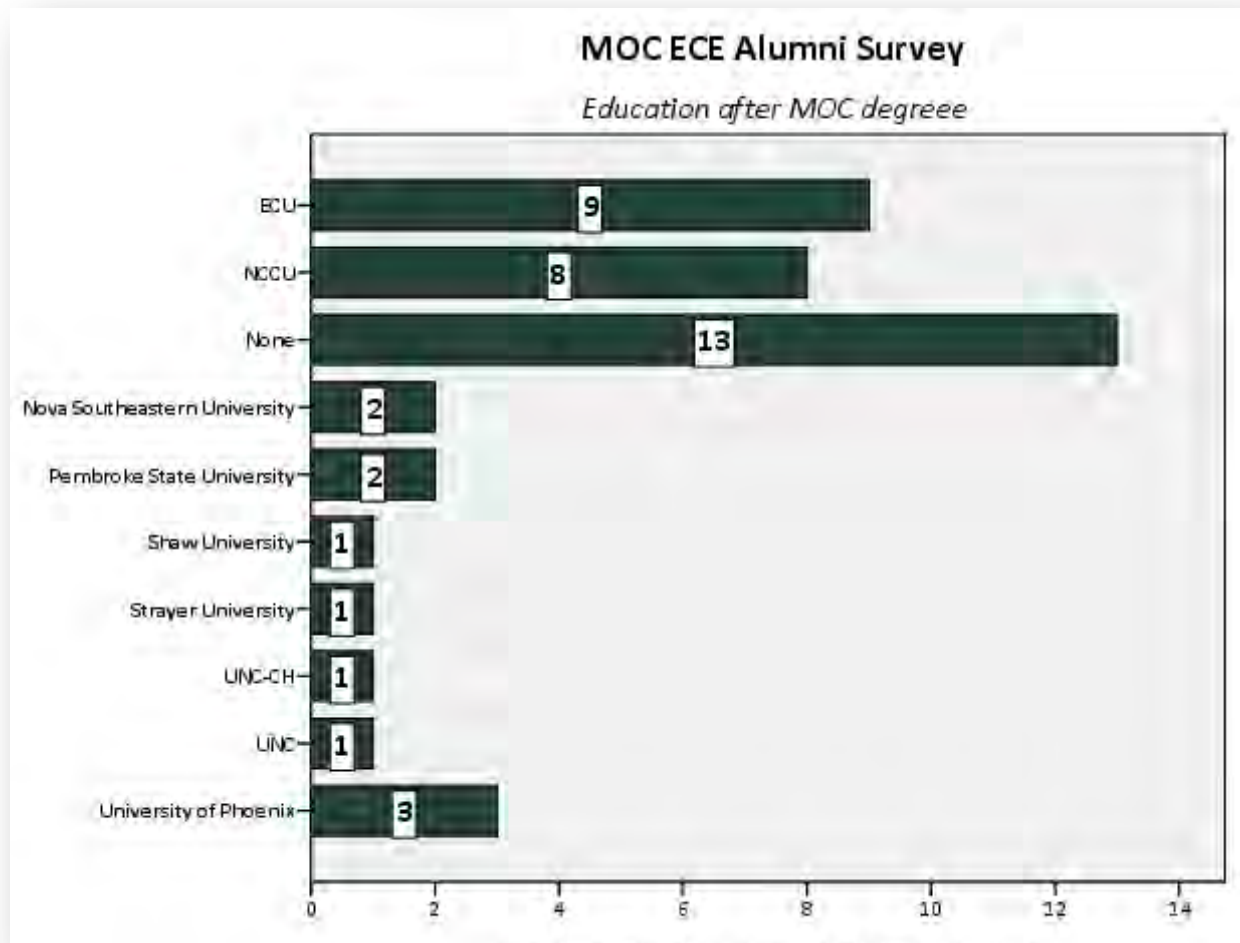
- **Figure 5: Planned Graduate/Professional School (May 2009 Graduates)**

## Early Childhood Education Program Alumni Survey

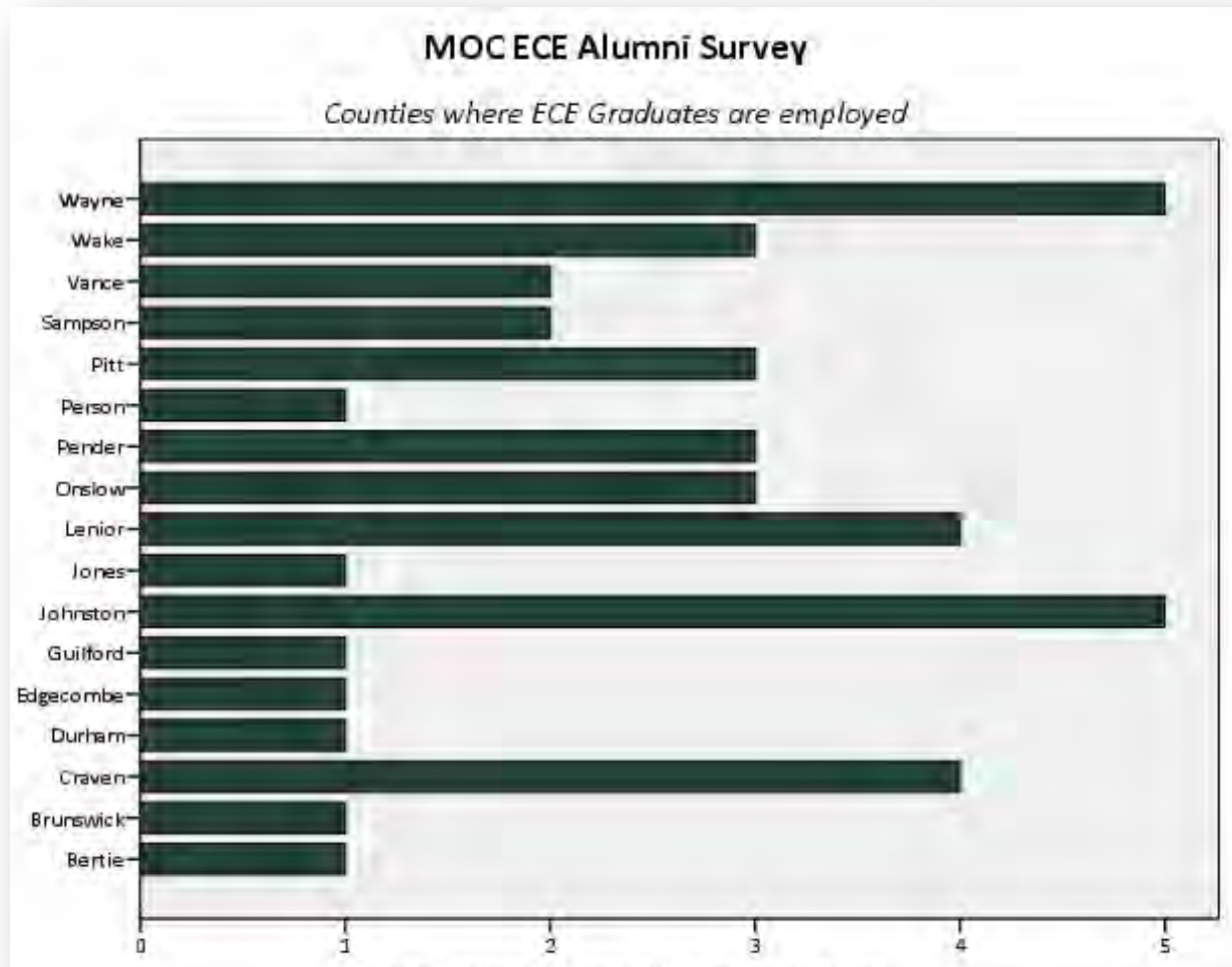
In addition to Mount Olive College's Graduation Survey, individual academic departments conduct surveys of their program graduates. The Education department conducted a 2008 survey of their **Early Childhood Education Program (ECE)** graduates (May 2004 through May 2008) in which they distributed 253 surveys with 41 alumni responses; a 6.02% response rate.

28 alumni responded to the question regarding what other institutions they attended after attaining their MOC degree.
