- All MOC Blackboard classes need 10 or more students to run. All Blackboard offerings are 3.0 semesters (Except BIO 120L, which is 1.0 s.h.)
- All courses are interactive and run for five weeks unless otherwise noted.
- **High Speed Internet Connection Is Required. Various courses include timed tests.**
- Registration Procedures: Contact your assessment counselor or advisor, register for the class, Log in on the first day of class. Follow instructions on lower half of the registration form.
- The last day to register for online courses is one week prior to the start date of the course.
- Courses dropped in the first five days only (last drop day is Friday, 5 pm.) will result in a complete refund. Courses dropped after the initial 5 days and up to the mid-point of the course will result in a grade of "W" and will be charged in full. Courses cannot be dropped after the mid-point of the course.
- These classes are in accelerated format and will require from 15 to 20 hours of work per week. Only independent, mature students can handle the workload and continuous responsibility that Internet classes demand.
